



Student Identification Card

You will **receive your** Student ID card with your photo, name and your student ID number **during School orientation**. This card shows you are part of Sunway University and helps you use different campus services. Remember, your ID card belongs to the university and cannot be passed to others. It is important to keep it safe and always have it with you while on campus. **If you happen to lose your student card, feel free to reach out to the Registry for guidance.**





Dress Code

Commuting to Campus

The **parking facilities** operate on a first-come, first-served basis. The campus basement parking is available at RM 5.00/day. Alternative parking at Sunway Pyramid and the Sunway BRT station is also available.



You may apply via <u>Sunway Smart Parking</u> or the Sunway Super App. Feel free to contact the nearest carpark helpdesk at Sunway Pyramid for further information. Kompleks BRT Sunway parking is available at RM 7.00/day. All parking rates are subject to change.

The **Free Shuttle Bus** operates within the city where the University is located and is available for all students, staff and visitors.

The university is also connected to the SunU-Monash BRT Station, which can be accessed via the **Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)-Sunway Line**.
