1.0 Purpose

1.1 Sunway University has been consistently advocating for a plastic-free campus ever since it became a full-fledged University in 2011. To this end, the Single-Use Plastic Policy was introduced to facilitate the plastic and other forms of waste minimization campaigns that started way back in 2012.

- 1.2 The policy aims to assist the Sunway community to take on a more unified and collective approach when handling plastic waste, moving completely away from single-use plastics to promoting reusable alternatives, in order to reduce waste as a whole.
- 1.3 The effectiveness of this policy will require structured and coordinated efforts from all parties involved to identify and reduce single-use plastics and switch to reusable alternatives wherever possible.
