APEL for Qualification, known as APEL.Q, is an initiative designed to award **formal academic qualifications** based on an individual's prior experiential learning. Developed to support lifelong learning, APEL.Q recognizes the knowledge, skills, and competencies acquired through work experience, non-formal education, and informal learning. This process allows individuals to obtain a qualification without following the traditional educational pathway, thus providing a flexible and inclusive approach to education and professional development.

What are the two programmes approved by MQA for Sunway University's APEL.Q pilots?





Great news for Sunway University, the APEL.Q Pilot is currently set to commence within the coming weeks! Part of the arduous process to gain accreditation for APEL.Q is for the University to conduct a Pilot programme; one that is currently being worked on by the APEL Unit of the Professional and Continuing Education (PACE) department at the School of Education.

Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning: Launch of APEL.C Courses

APEL for Credit Award, known as APEL.C, was developed by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA) to support lifelong learning by assessing and recognising the value of learning that takes place beyond formal classroom settings. The successful completion of the APEL.C assessment will result in the applicant receiving a credit award for a course in their programmes, thus allowing for a faster programme completion.

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Micro-credentials: Upskilling through Flexible and Accessible Learning

Micro-credentials are a certification of assessed learning of a single or a set of courses intended to impart knowledge, skills, values and competencies in an area. They are designed to be more flexible and accessible than traditional degrees, allowing learners to quickly gain expertise and demonstrate their competencies to employers. Micro-credentials are often digital and can be credit bearing or otherwise.

By enrolling in micro-credentials, learners can experience more flexibility in learning, build a portfolio of learning, experience a personalised learning path that is cost-effective, and improve their employability. Furthermore, these courses can be stacked towards a larger qualification or certification, making them a valuable tool for continuous professional development and lifelong learning!


Seizing this opportunity, the School of Education at Sunway University has been diligently working with top integrity and anti-corruption experts to deliver KIAR to all of Sunway University's students. Through a cutting-edge online-centric pedagogical approach and the application of the HyFlex model of delivery, the School of Education aims to provide an enriching learning experience and maximum flexibility to the learners' learning journey.

HyFlex, short for Hybrid Flexible, is an instructional model that combines face-to-face and online learning. It provides students with the flexibility to choose their mode of participation for each class session, whether in a traditional classroom, via live online streaming, or through asynchronous activities at their own pace. This approach supports diverse learning preferences and schedules, allowing for a more personalized and inclusive educational experience.

The course features activities such as "Integrity and Anti-Corruption" themed Snakes and Ladders, ethical scenario simulations, and real-world case studies. These interactive elements make complex topics more accessible and engaging. Students can earn badges, move up leaderboards, and tackle real-world challenges in a digital environment. By integrating educational content with interactive activities, KIAR aims to educate and motivate a new generation of ethical leaders ready to combat corruption in today's world.


