Sunway University Soars to #81 in THE Impact Rankings 2025

Sunway University has achieved a landmark global ranking of #81 out of 2,318 universities in the Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Rankings 2025, a dramatic rise from last year's 201-300 band. The University submitted data for six SDGs and was ranked in the global Top 100 for all six, including five in the Top 50 and two in the Top 25.
