



# **ADTP STUDY PLAN**

The ADTP accepts students for ALL majors. For most majors, students spend two years of their studies in Malaysia and the final two years in the U.S. Students are required to take core subjects and General Education courses. The flexibility of the program allows other transfer arrangements for liberal art requirements where students can undertake one year of study in Malaysia and complete the last three years in the U.S.

Students must obtain the minimum grade of "C" to meet the eligibility of transfer requirements. More competitive universities have higher admission requirements and academic standards. It is very important for students to refer to the specific university's admission criteria, transfer requirements and application processes.

#### Finding your best-fit university

ADTP offers a 'University Life-Freshman Seminar' subject focusing on helping students to excel socially and academically in higher education. This subject covers the needed skills to identify and prepare for transfer.

#### THERE ARE MORE THAN **1.000 MAJORS AVAILABLE** FOR AN ADTP STUDENT TO VENTURE INTO

Studying in the ADTP consists of subjects from the following categories:

#### **CORE SUBJECTS**

These are the subjects required for entry into a particular major. Students need to complete these subjects before taking their major subjects. Subjects in this area may range between 20 and 30 credits.

#### ★ GENERAL EDUCATION SUBJECTS

The subjects in this area are compulsory for all students. These subjects will give students an overview of other disciplines and help in their future career advancement. Subjects in this area may range between 25 and 35 credits.

#### ★ PROFICIENCY SUBJECTS

Subjects in this area will equip the students with the necessary skills needed for university education. Students may be exempted from these subjects if they can provide evidence that they obtained the acquired skills needed. Subjects in these area are:

#### ★ MOHE SUBJECTS

Subjects in this area are required by the Ministry of Higher Education. The subjects will help students appreciate the Malaysian culture better. This is ideal for students if they have a background in performance with an interest in solo performance and/or ensemble playing. Music Performance graduates will be equipped for a professional career in the music industry as performers, educators, and session musicians, utilizing a broad exposure to other related areas, including composition and arrangement.
